Commemoration service

A bilingual service to commemorate the late Queen Elizabeth II will take place at Christ Church Cathedral on Sunday 18 September at 4 pm. The Lieutenant Governor of Quebec, The Honourable J. Michel Doyon will be in attendance, as well as other civic guests.

This will be a time of mourning for the Anglican community, as well as for anyone who wishes to join in a moment of remembrance for the late Queen. The service will be led by the Bishop of Montreal, the Rt Reverend Mary Irwin-Gibson and by the Dean of the Cathedral, the Very Rev'd Bertrand Olivier. It will be open to the public and also livestreamed on our YouTube channel.

Civic services such as this one are an opportunity to showcase the vitality and hospitality of the Cathedral, so I would encourage you to attend if you are able to, not only to pause and pray for the Queen, but also share with visitors the warmth of our community.
